Political correctness recently motivated his hometown of Milford, PA to dismantle handsome monument over his remains & replace it with apologetic plaque. References to him have been eliminated from local history. This is the original biography of Tom Quick, published in 1851; containing virtually every tale associated with craft & cunning of Tom Quick, & many narratives relating to early settlers of the upper Delaware Valley. Of special interest to historians are the chapters devoted to the Battle of Minisink during American Revolution; abridged version, published 1894, lacks several key chapters, footnotes & Appendix.
