

He was sued by James Joyce, tangled with T.S. Eliot and Ezra Pound, and was involved in the Alger Hiss embroglio. Two books by Samuel Roth are presented here. 
Just wanted to drop you a line concerning your annotations of Pink's "Sovereignty of God," which I just recently finished reading. I found myself looking forward to your notes while reading, because they are so keenly logical and very insightful. It almost seems like the author and annotator should switch, since you have obviously more understanding than the author, and it is often painful to see how little Pink seems to be aware of (and hopefully his "ignorance" was not feigned for evil purposes). I found myself wondering many times if Pink were actually trying to steer the reader astray, since it seems impossible for someone to be so inconsistent in what they profess. If someone doesn't know something about subject A, then he will consistently show his ignorance of subject A whenever it comes up. How can he do anything else? But with Pink, he shows that he knows something about subject A when it first comes up, but then later he shows his ignorance of the same subject by contradicting exactly what he said the first time it came up! How can this be innocently done? I would like to give him the benefit of the doubt, but I have to admit that it is very difficult.

It must have been exhausting for you to annotate this work, and I want to thank you VERY MUCH for all your hard work and perseverance. I also learned a great deal about my own superficial reading style and how I tend to sift through the haystack looking for the needle but often dismiss the parts that are not of interest without really analyzing them at all. I had read "Sovereignty of God" before your annotated version, but in reading the annotated version, I felt like I had not read the book at all! I can clearly see how easy it is to steer readers where you want them to go, and, frankly, it is quite scary. I will certainly read more carefully from now on, thanks to your example!

I find that I am learning to be more logical and rational in my thinking just by reading your works. I am noticing things I didn't notice before, and I am seeing logical inconsistencies now that I didn't in the past. And this is because of your example, which is also a form of teaching. I appreciate this very much and wanted to let you know how important your work is - for this reason as well as for the obvious reason of correcting errors of logic and doctrine.
