





When Harvey was arrested in the Texas Theater some 40 minutes later, he was carrying a .38 revolver which, of course, does not eject its shells. Harvey also at the time, astonishing to detectives, had a wallet carrying the same two ID cards.

Walter Bower or Bowmaker (1385-1449) was a 15th Century Scottish canon and abbot of Inchcolm Abbey (in the Firth of Forth) and was a reputed chronicler. The illustration on the front cover of this book is from Bower's epic Chronicle, Scotichronicon and portrays Scota and Goidel Glas, the legendary progenitors of the Irish and Scottish Gaels; which work was a continuation of John of Fordun's (c.1355-1384) Chronica Gentis Scotorum, the oldest extant complete history of the Scots. Bower's Scotichronicon was published in 16 books: the first 5 and part of the 6th (to A.D. 1163) were Fordun's works, augmented by Bower; and some subsequent volumes [to the reign of Robert I. (1371)] he heavily relied upon Fordun's Gesta Annalia; however, after that point the work is entirely original, up to the death of King James I. of Scotland (in whose royal counsels he was active [1424-1427], as well as being an administrator in the collection of taxes and as a judge in cases brought before Parliament). He began the work in 1440 and completed it in 1447 and continued to edit and revise it until his death.

In 1991, Donald E. R. Watt, Ph.D. (1926-2004), Scottish historian and professor of Medieval History, and Emeritus Professor of Scottish Church History at St. Andrews University, Scotland) concerning Bower's Scotichronicon: "We are more and more convinced that this book is one of the national treasures of Scotland, which should be studied in depth for many different kinds of enquiry into Scotland's past." Bower himself had written: "He is not a Scot who is not pleased with this book."





Bernal Diaz del Castillo (1496-1584) wrote an important firsthand account of his experiences supporting several expeditions into Central America, including that of Hernan Cortes in the conquest of Mexico in 1521. It's the straightforward account of a soldier, not the dainty and carefully balanced prose of an academic or diplomat. It is thus devoid of "political correctness." This volume allows Diaz to tell his story as he would have it, and, besides his observations of the Aztec people and their temples, he describes their massive ritual sacrifices—the details of which are many times excised from modern history books.

- "Jews Must Live" (unabridged edition) and "Now and Forever", Samuel Roth, 369pp., pb., 27.00 + P&H.

Two unabridged books in one paperback. Samuel Roth (1893-1974) was a decades-long publisher of pornographic materials and a plaintiff in Roth v. United States (1957), a key Supreme Court ruling on freedom of sexual expression. The minority opinion of that case, regarding redeeming social value as a criterion in obscenity prosecutions, became a template for the liberalizing First Amendment decisions in the 1960s. He was sued by James Joyce, tangled with T.S. Eliot and Ezra Pound, and was involved in the Alger Hiss embroglio. Two books by Samuel Roth are presented here. Jews Must Live includes the full text and all illustrations from the original. This is in contrast to a previous 1964 edition which had only half the book. Roth's narrative forms in part a candid exposé of Jewish ritual murder. His testimony has now been given new life in this book. Also includes Roth's Now and Forever: In this strange little book—also presented in full text—Roth discusses the state of Jewry with Israel Zangwill. Zangwill was a playwright who coined the phrase "melting pot." Also included are three related essays—one by Martin Glynn and two by Marcus Eli Ravage.

—an extraordinarily important book that traces America's slide into fascism and subservience to a foreign power.

Felton argues persuasively that three groups have converged and come to dominate American policy for the benefit of Israel: the neoconservatives, the Republican evangelicals (Christian Zionists), and Jewish Zionists. He backs up his analysis with over 800 footnoted references to government, scholarly and media sources.

Felton refutes the traditional progressive view that Israel is merely a client state of America. If this is so, he asks, how has America come to pursue policies that are so utterly contrary to their own national interest while being so highly beneficial to its junior partner?

Felton also refutes the theory that 'it's all about oil,' arguing that the First Persian Gulf War was the last American oil war and that the Second Persian Gulf War ignored the interests of American oil companies, increased American oil costs and reduced American national security. How could this have happened? The Second War, he demonstrates, can only be adequately explained by the take-over of American foreign and domestic policy for the benefit of Israel.

Felton's book integrates a remarkable range of relevant material, including:

the decline of American republican government from Vietnam to the present;

the rise of American fascism since the Reagan years;

the rise of the pro-Israel lobby in America and its growing influence on the presidency from 1948 until now;

the subjugation of America's House and Senate by the pro-Israel lobby;

the anti-democratic philosophy of Leo Strauss and its corrosive influence on America via the neoconservative movement;

the growth and goals of the Project for a New American Century (PNAC) and other right-wing think tanks;

PNAC's search for a new 'Pearl Harbor' to permit the restructuring of America;

The Israeli foreign policy goal of dismembering Iraq to ensure Israeli regional domination; the demonization of Islam;

the origins and rise of the religious right in America and its obsession with Israel;

the planned attack on Iran that is being pushed by Israel and its proxies in America; the extremely gloomy prospects for America to "return to normal"

Felton is generous in his praise of others who have explored some of this material such as John Mearsheimer, Stephen Walt, Jimmy Carter and Paul Findley. Felton's book, however, is a far more comprehensive study of the subject and integrates a much fuller range of issues and data to demonstrate the self-destructive nature of American policy in our time.

For those who imagine that America's Mideast policy is motivated by "love of justice and democracy," Felton reviews America's shameful and ongoing record of supporting dictators and overthrowing democratically elected third world governments.

For those who pretend that America's Mideast policy is intended to serve America's self-interest, Felton reviews the appalling cost to America of its pro-Israel policy: thousands of dead American soldiers; trillions of dollars of debt incurred over the years due to higher oil costs and ruinous wars; the enmity of the world; and the destruction of the American system of republican government.

And what has America gained by supporting Israel? Nothing, Felton argues, that can begin to justify the appalling cost.

The book's cover makes it clear that 'Israel's Fifth column' includes secular neocon crooks like Rumsfeld and Cheney; Christian evangelical maniacs like Bush; and Jewish Zionist power players like Perle, Feith and Wolfowitz.
